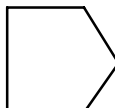

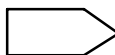


3 BASIC INSPECTION

- (a) Basic inspection.
- (1) Check the battery voltage.
Standard: 11 to 14 V
- (b) Check the power supply to the radio receiver assy.
- (1) Turn the ignition switch to the ACC position.
- (2) Check whether or not the display appears on the radio receiver assy.

DISPLAY APPEARS (GO TO STEP 4)

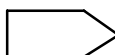
4 DTC CHECK (SEE PAGE 05-1618)

If the audio system is equipped with a multi-display, check DTCs in the NAVIGATION SYSTEM section(see page 05-1757).

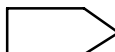


DTC IS OUTPUT (GO TO STEP 9)
